Welcome to The Alzheimer's Project, Inc., 2010 Forget Me Not Walk and Fall Festival! This year, the Alzheimer's Project invites you to build a team! A team consists of you and at least one other person (No team is too big or too small)! Each team member will need to raise at least \$25 (\$15 for student teams). Team members will receive a walk T-shirt, a raffle ticket for amazing prizes and a lunch ticket on the day of the event! There will be a grand prize for the top individual fundraiser and special recognition for the Top Team Fundraiser (Student and non-student). Here are a few ideas about how to raise some extra \$\$\$ for The Alzheimer's Project, Inc., event!

12 Creative Fundraising Events

1. Jeans or Casual Dress Day

If your school, organization or place of business has a strict dress code, opt for a day when people can donate a small amount (for example, \$5) in exchange for the option to wear jeans or casual dress. For an ongoing fundraiser, make it a regular Friday event.

2. Spaghetti Dinner

Spaghetti is a low-cost meal that's easy to make in large amounts, and everyone loves it! Some other fun, low-cost dinner options are pancakes and hotdogs. Add a twist and have a black-tie pancake supper. You can also make this a hot breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea or brunch event.

3. Dollar Walk

Invite supporters to help pave your "Dollar Walk" with dollar bills. Outline your walk in a hallway or large room with colored tape. Use masking tape (preferably one that isn't sticky enough to tear paper) to tape donated dollar bills as stepping-stones on your walk.

4. Yard Sale

One person's trash is almost always another person's treasure, which is why yard sales are such fun and successful events. Collect items from your team members and sell them to earn money toward your Forget Me Not Walk fundraising goal!

5. Trivia or Bingo Night

A bingo or trivia game night is an easy way to raise some funds. Sell bingo cards for a few dollars each and get some prizes donated for the winners. You can host this event at someone's home or at a local bar or restaurant.

6. Silent Auction

Collect items from local retailers, sports teams and restaurants for an auction. Combine a silent auction with a dinner or wine-tasting event.

7. Raffle

Ask a local business to donate goods or a service for a raffle. Some unique ideas include spa days, a GPS system, cooking classes or a weekend getaway.

8. Wine Tasting

Host a wine-tasting event at one of your favorite local restaurants. Guests purchase tickets which allow them to sample wine selections and learn about different varietals. You can add a silent auction or raffle to this event to raise even more money.

9. Karaoke Night

Host a karaoke night at a local bar or restaurant. Attendees can donate to sing a song. Spice things up a little and have people donate to get their friends on (or off) stage!

10. Skating Party

Host a party at a roller-skating or ice-skating rink. Many businesses are more than willing to donate their facilities to nonprofit groups, especially at times that are slower for them. You may also be able to get food and drinks donated or a portion of the proceeds from the food sales.

11. Car Wash

Everybody's car gets dirty! Many of us hate washing our cars. This is a great way for people to get out of doing the washing themselves and is a great fundraiser. Or, mix it up a little and do a pet wash.

12. Candy Sale

Who doesn't need a little sugar from time to time? Rather than paying the vending machine, have money go to your fundraising! **Remember:** Candy can be purchased inexpensively in bulk!
